<p>Community Free Dental Clinic 2341 Whitesburg Drive, Huntsville, Alabama 35801</p> <p>Open by appointment only; no walk-ins</p> <p>The clinic provides free dental services to low income, elderly and veterans living at or below the poverty level in Madison County.</p> <p>Please call the office on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday afternoons at 1:00 PM as we are only open when we have a dentist.</p> <p>Due to the overwhelming need for tooth extractions, this is the clinic’s primary focus.</p> <p><u>Am I Eligible?</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The clinic sees patients 19 years of age or older and who are residents of Madison County.</li> <li>• Patient eligibility must be verified with two pieces of identification, one of which must have a current photograph and verification of income.</li> <li>• Income levels <b>must be</b> equal to or less than 150% of the national poverty level.</li> <li>• Patients must be without dental insurance.</li> </ul> <p>The clinic serves the following areas: Huntsville, Madison, Owens Cross Roads, Toney, Gurley, New Hope, Triana, Harvest, New Market, Hazel Green, Meridianville, Moore Mill, and Redstone.</p>	<p>256-489-1853</p>
